Subject Overviews

Writing

T (ଜୁଲ୍ଲାକ୍ରାମ୍ବର) There will be activities during our independent learning that will strengthen their muscles ready for writing. We will have opportunity to mark make using a wide range of media including crayons, paint, markers, pencils and through messy play. The children will begin to recognise that print carries meaning through looking at books and seeing writing around the nursery. Adults will model how to use a pencil or pen to write and children will be working on how to hold a pen or pencil correctly.

Reading

The children will learn Nursery Rhymes and will be encouraged to join in. Children will explore and listen for rhyming words. They will develop their listening skills as we share lots of books. Some of the stories we will read together for our topic this term are We are all different, I like myself, What type of Family are we, I can be anything and Real Superhero's. We will have lots of activities during our independent learning related to these stories so that children can explore the topics creatively through their play. At the end of each session we will have story and singing time before home time.


Maths


The children will learn to sing lots of different number songs involving counting forwards and backwards. We will focus on sorting and grouping objects by size, colour or shape. Following on from this we will focus on copying and extending simple patterns.

Topic


Our topics this half term are All About Me and People Who Help Us. Through our All About Me topic, we will talk about what we like about ourselves, what we are good at and our families. We will also consider people who help us in our community. We can't wait to see where our learning takes us!



Personal Social and Emotional

Children new to nursery will focus on settling in this half term. We are getting good at leaving our parents/ carers in the morning with a smile. The children are learning many new routines and rules in school, luckily we have some children from last year to help show them what needs to happen next. We are making lots of new friends and becoming more confident at saying what we need.

Communication and Language

The children will practise listening attentively in a variety of situations. This will be through listening to stories and poems. They will practise joining in with familiar and repeated expressions in these stories. They will begin to communicate their needs appropriately including talking about their likes and dislikes. Adults will model speaking in full sentences and will encourage the children to use new vocabulary. We will encourage the children to use words to explain to others what they want or need.

Physical Development

Children will be able to explore the outside area in Nursery where they can use the bikes, balls, balancing equipment as well as our large scale building blocks. During the children's PE lessons will also experiment with moving in different ways— crawling, slithering, running, jumping, and hopping. We will encourage the children to become more independent in going to the toilet and putting on their own coats. Please ask the children to show you how they can do things all by themselves when they are at home. They will have many opportunities to develop their fine motor skills for example through threading, using tweezers, playing with play dough and mark making.

Understanding the World

The children will explore the similarities and differences between themselves and their families. We will encourage them to talk about how they are the same and different to others in their family. We will be exploring simple routes that the children take like getting to school or to various places in Wolverton.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will listen to storytelling and create our own stories using props. We will experiment with paint using different paint brushes, sponges and printing material as well as learning to mixing colours to create new colours. The children have free access to a variety of paper, art materials, collage materials to create their own pictures. We will sing lots of Nursery Rhymes and simple songs. The children will also have singing and music sessions with Mrs Rawlence (Music Teacher). The children will have the opportunity to explore various construction materials to build models as well as using junk modelling to created different models.

Parent Reminder:

- · Please put water in water bottles not juice
- Please make sure that you label every item of clothing to help the children keep track of their belongings.
- Please remind your child to change their story book once it is read and have fun reading a range of stories at home.
- Encourage children to sing you some of our counting song we have been learning (see ILD for words to some counting song we are learning)
